INFORMATION

Bring money for dinner (see options below). Understand that food prices are a bit higher in the city, even at places that we have here in town.

It is customary to dress up when attending a live symphony orchestra concert. That said, plan for warm temperatures and appropriate shoes for walking to dinner. Avoid t shirts, gym shoes, jeans, and shorts.

ITINERARY

- 2:15 PM** ***Meet at Normal West – back door by the band room, load and depart for the Loop***
The Loop is the central business district in Downtown Chicago
- about 5:00 PM** ***Arrive in the Loop, dinner on your own (with other members of our group)***
This is a relatively safe part of the city, but no one is to travel on their own.
Nearby choices include Potbelly Sandwich Shop, Corner Bakery Café, McDonalds, Chipotle, Jimmy John's, Burger King, Shake Shack – some are closer than others...
After dinner would be a great time to hit the Symphony Store for CSO merchandise and the lobby for Star Wars merchandise.
- 6:15 PM** ***The conductor is giving a pre-concert lecture in Symphony Center at 6:15 PM. You are invited to attend this, but it is not required. The lectures typically last 30 minutes or so.***
- 7:00 PM** ***Meet in front of Orchestra Hall (on Michigan Avenue, across the street from the Art Institute's famous lion statues) You will receive your tickets, and we will be seated.***
- 7:30 PM** ***Star Wars: Return of the Jedi begins, with the soundtrack performed live by the Chicago Symphony Orchestra***
- Shortly after 10 PM** ***Program ends, use restrooms, load coach for home***
- 12:45 AM** ***Approximate arrival at NCWHS***
